Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the works/projects completed under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in the country, State and sector-wise;
- (b) the details of the companies provided assistance and the works/projects completed under the CSR in Andhra Pradesh, district and sector-wise;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries of such CSR projects/works in Andhra Pradesh, districtwise;
- (d) the details and the names of the projects which have not been completed under CSR in Andhra Pradesh along with the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government has audited CSR funds spent by the aforementioned companies and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. However, the present CSR filing does not capture the beneficiary-wise details of the CSR projects of the companies. Further, completion status of CSR projects or activities are not maintained separately by the Government.

On the basis of the filings made by the companies in the MCA21 registry, State /UT-wise and development sector-wise details of CSR spent by all the companies during last three Financial Years (FY) 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are at Annexure –I & II respectively. Further, the district-wise and development sector-wise CSR spent by all the companies in the state of Andhra Pradesh during last three FY 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2020-21 are at Annexure-III & IV respectively.

(e): Under the Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities based on the recommendations of its CSR Committee. The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. The CSR mandated companies are required to provide additional information in its Profit & Loss Account regarding amount of expenditure incurred on CSR activities, which is required to be audited by the statutory auditor of the company. Further, the Board of the company is also required to disclose in Board report, the CSR Policy developed and implemented by the company, including the details like funds earmarked, expenditure made, implementing agencies appointed etc. The corporate governance framework along with the existing legal provisions such as mandatory disclosures, accountability of the CSR Committee and the Board, provisions for statutory audit of accounts of the company etc. provide sufficient safeguards in this regard.
