Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of LPG connections provided under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) since the inception of the scheme till November, 2022, State/UT-wise, especially in the Jhalawar and Baran districts of Rajasthan, classified as active and inactive;
- (b) the number of refillings done under Ujjwala Yojana during the last two years including in Jhalawar and Baran districts of Rajasthan;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to run any campaign to increase this number and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of refillings done under the said scheme during the last one year in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan categorized as one refill, two refills, three refills and four or more refills?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 26 BY DR. DHAL SINGH BISEN AND SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH TO BE ANSWERED ON 8<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2022 REGARDING ‘LPG CONNECTIONS UNDER PMUY’.**

(a) State/UT-wise details of LPG connections released under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) since inception of the scheme till November, 2022 are at **Annexure**. Details of LPG connections released under PMUY since inception of the scheme till November, 2022 in the districts of Jhalawar and Baran of Rajasthan are as under :-

(b) Details of number of refills consumed by PMUY beneficiaries in 2020-21 and 2021-22 across the country including Jhalawar and Baran districts of Rajasthan are as under :-

(c) To improve LPG usage amongst PMUY beneficiaries, Government and Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have organized LPG panchayats, social media campaigns, public events for the distribution of connections and public awareness campaigns etc. across the country. Conducting LPG Panchayats across the country is an ongoing process and so far 381 and 285 LPG Panchayats have been conducted in Baran and Jalawar districts of Rajasthan respectively.

Further, Government has taken several other steps to encourage consumption of LPG by PMUY beneficiaries, which include subsidy of ₹ 200/- per 14.2 Kg refill upto 12 refills/year for PMUY beneficiaries for year 2022-23, option of 5 Kg Double Bottle Connection (DBC), swap option from 14.2 Kg to 5 Kg, upto 3 free refills to PMUY beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package from April to December 2020 etc.

(d) As on 31.03.2021, there were 71.43 lakh and 63.59 lakh PMUY beneficiaries in the States of Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan respectively. Details of number of PMUY customers who have taken one refill, two refills, three refills, four or more refills during the last year i.e. 2021-22 in the States of Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan are as under :-
