**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of Central assistance to the States under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) for labour during the last three years and the current year, year-wise and scheme-wise including Maharashtra;**
- (b) the number of labourers who got benefitted from the above schemes during the said period; and**
- (c) the details of help extended by the Union Government in this regard to State Governments to improve the condition of labourers in the country?**

**(a) to (c): Ministry of Labour and Employment is implementing two Centrally Sponsored Scheme Namely National Career Service (NCS) and Coaching and Guidance for SC/ST and Other Backward Classes. The central assistance to the States/UTs is provided under the NCS scheme only. Funds are released to States/UTs against their proposals for establishment of Model Career Centre under the NCS scheme. Details of the funds released to State/UTs (including Maharashtra) under NCS scheme during last three years and current year are as under:**
