**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS**

**(a) the number of National Highway (NH) projects taken up for upgradation during the last five years in the country, State-wise;**

**(b) the time period likely to be taken for their completion;**

**(c) whether the Government proposes to put more emphasis on the completion of ongoing projects rather than taking up new projects as the progress of ongoing upgradation work of a number of important NHs is very slow; and**

**(d) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). The details of NH projects awarded during the last five years, is annexed.**

**(b) Time period for completion of projects is generally kept as 2-3 years.**

**(c) & (d) The Ministry is giving emphasis to both the timely completion of ongoing projects, and to the taking up of new projects. The Ministry is closely monitoring construction progress and proactively working with project implementing agencies, State Governments, contractors / developers, to resolve issues / bottlenecks in projects and speed up the pace of construction on NHs. Periodic review meetings are being held at various levels, and several steps have been taken to expedite the completion of pending works.**
