Title: Regarding Road Project near Tirupati West Railway Station -Laid.

SHRI N. REDDEPPA (CHITTOOR): The Tirupati West Railway station is an important railway station in the Tirupati district of Andhra Pradesh. It serves as the second station besides the Tirupati main station, falling under the Guntakal Division of the South Central Railway Zone.

Given the close proximity of the Tirupati West Railway Station to many schools and universities, there is an essential need to construct a road from the Tirupati West Railway Station passing through the Padmavathi campus school back side to the West Church. This road project is essential for the development of the Tirupati West Railway Station as it will provide great convenience to the students, employees and residents in that locality.

Several representations to this effect have already been communicated to the Government but no progress has been made so far. Hence, I urge upon the Government to take necessary action for speedy initiation of work for the said road, which will go a long way in enhancing rail connectivity in the region.
