DEATH OF SHRI TYABJI

Mr. Speaker: I have to inform the House of the sad demise of a sitting Member, Shri F. B. Tyabji who passed away at 2:30 this morning at the Willingdon Hospital. He had a heart attack yesterday afternoon and was admitted to the Hospital. He was only 53 years old

Shri Tyabji was elected to the Second Lok Sabha from the Jaina constituency of Bombay State.

He was a prominent member of the House and a highly cultured man who 198

used to take prominent part in debates. During the short period he was a member of this House he made his mark by his effective contribution and endeared himself to all by his great qualities of head and heart.

We mourn the loss of this friend and I am sure the House will join with me in conveying our condolences to the family of the deceased.
