

Bridge at Kumbar Taleo (Solapur)

6386. SHRI DHARMANNA MONDAYYA SADUL: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there was any proposal to construct an overbridge near Kumbar Taleo two km. from Solapur on Solapur-Bijapur road (N.H. 13);

(b) whether the Government of Maharashtra and his Ministry have decided to provide funds for this project; and

(c) the present status of the project and the steps being taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALIKARJUN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(c) The proposal for the work is, at present, in planning stage with respect to finalisation of plans/estimate and apportionment of cost between the State Government and the Railways.
