#### **Allocation to Bihar for Power Generation**

The Government of Bihar proposed an outlay of Rs. 423 crores for the power sector (excluding Rural electrification) in their Annual Plan for 1991-92, against which the Planning-Commission recommended an outlay of Rs. 437.18 crores at the Working group level.
