(a) to (d): As per the information received from the State Government of Mizoram, a Detailed Project Report for 460 MW Kolodyne Hydro Electric Project (HEP) was prepared in the year 2008 by the Central Water Commission and concurred by the Central Electricity Authority on 14.09.2011. Memorandum of Agreement was signed by the State Government with M/s. National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) on 22.12.2008 for execution of the project. But the project was found to be economically unviable as the levalized tariff worked out to be ₹11/unit at 2010 Price Level and the MoA signed between Government of Mizoram and NTPC was terminated on 01.06.2020.
