MODES OF TRAINING UNDER DDU-GKY

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the modes of training being provided to youths under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), State and districtwise particularly in the States of Haryana, Gujarat, Patliputra of Bihar and Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) whether any special education project has also been prepared for them in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide employment to such youths after the completion of said training programme and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any financial benefits are being provided to the rural youths; and
- (e) if so, the number of beneficiaries, State and district-wise particularly Patliputra of Bihar?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT
(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) The training being imparted to the youths under DDU-GKY is based on the qualification packs approved by National Skills Qualification Committee. The training consists of theory, practical and on-the job training (OJT) imparted in domain skills, computer skills, soft skills and English skills.
- (b) No special education project has been formulated under DDU-GKY.
- (c) Under DDU-GKY, placement of the trained candidate is to be arranged by Project Implementation Agency(PIA). All payments to the PIA is linked to achieving outcome of the program i.e. the placement of trained candidate. DDU-GKY scheme guidelines mandate a minimum of 70% placement of total trained candidates. Further, job fairs and employers meet are also organised by State Rural Livelihood Missions & State Skill Development Missions implementing DDU-GKY in the State for facilitating placement.
- (d) DDU-GKY guidelines provide for the following financial benefit to the candidate other than Training Cost & Assessment Cost: 1. Boarding & Lodging for Residential Trainees 2. Post Placement Support, 3.Uniform, 4. Food & Transport for Non Residential Trainees, 5. Travel Support, 6. Retention Support, 7. Career Progression Support 8. Counselling support including medical checkups for candidates placed in foreign countries 9. Mobile top-up support @ Rs. 50 per month for a period of 12 months is also

permissible within the Scheme for mobile tracking of the trainee. Details are provided in **Annexure-1**.

(e) District-wise number of beneficiaries of DDU-GKY is not maintained Centrally. State-wise number of beneficiaries is given in **Annexure-2**
