The Mlalster of Education and Natural Resources and Sclentific Research (Maulame Azad): 741 scholarships have so far been granted for the year 1952 53 to students from Madras of the Backward Classes which term includes Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. 327 more scholarships are likely to be awarded shortly.

## Sele Sutpiciency in Motor Spirit

The Minister of Education and Natural Resources and Sclentific Re search (Maulana Axad): (a) The Government have under consideration the following steps to attain sef-sufficiency in motorspirit:-
(1) Geological and Geophysical prospecting for new resources of oil in the country.
(2) Development of petroleum reflnlng industry using imported crude petroleum.
(3) Increasing praduction of power alcohol.
(4) Use of alcohol-petrol mixtures in place of neat petrol.
(b) Laboratory and small-scale e $x^{-}$ periments for production of synthetic oil from coal have been carried out at the Fuel Research Institute, Dhanbad. The small-scale trials will have to be tried out on a large scale before plens for production on a commercial scale can be drawn up.
(c) and (d). A survey of low-grade coal of Bihar and Bengal was uridertaken by a special survey party of the Geological Survey of India in 1948.
