AHAL-LUNGLEH ROAD

- 588. Shri Rishang Keishing: Will the Minister of Transport be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Mizo people of Lushai hills have built the Aijal-Lungleh Road by volunteer labour;
- (b) whether the State Government and the Government of India by way of encouragement have granted Rs. 15,000 and Rs. 5,00,000 respectively; and
- (c) whether Government propose to make the Aijal-Lungleh Road into all season motorable road?
- The Deputy Minister of Railways and Transport (Shri Alagesan): (a) The Mizo people with the help of the Assam Rifles have improved the existing Aijal-Lungleh bridle path in sections over a distance of about 75 miles to make it "jeepable" and built about 15 miles of new road 8 to 12 ft. wide.
- (b) A grant of Rs. 1.08 lakts has been so far sanctioned by the Assam Government towards the cost of this project and a proposal to make a further grant from the Road Fund is under consideration. The State Government have also undertaken maintenance of 72 miles of this road at an annual cost of nearly one lakh of rupees.
- (c) The intention is to maintain this road as an all-weather jeepable road for the present.
