The Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri): (a) The Police are maintaining strict vigilance and have adopted various measures to check crime. The whole town is being patrolled day and night by the police on foot, by cycles and in mobile vans. About 1500 police personnel are deputed every night on patrolling duty. A central Control Room is operating at the Parliament Street Police Station to attend to all immediate calls which are passed on to mobile vans by wireless.

(b) The matter is expected to receive consideration in due course.

(c) Does not arise.

Survey by World Bank Experts

119. Shri Muhammed Elias: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

(a) whether the World Bank experts have completed their survey for the development of Calcutta city; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Finance (Shri Morarji Desai): (a) The World Bank has not been entrusted with the survey for the development of Calcutta city; the survey has been undertaken by the Calcutta Metropolitan Planning Organisation set up by the West Bengal Government.

Bhadravati Iron and Steel Works

120. Shri Basappa: Will the Minister of Steel and Heavy Industries be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Bhadravati Iron and Steel Works have been converted into a Corporation; and

(b) what steps have been taken to convert this factory to produce mainly special steels?

The Minister of Steel and Heavy Industries (Shri C. Subramaniam): (a) Yes, Sir. A corporation was formed on the 30th June, 1961, and it has taken over the management of the Mysore Iron and Steel Works, Bhadravati, from 1st April, 1962.

(b) Government have under consideration a proposal received from the Mysore Government for manufacturing 15,000 tons per annum of high grade alloy and special steel bars at the Works. This is in addition to the steel expansion scheme already sanctioned by Government for production of 100,000 tons per annum of steel ingots to be converted into 85,000 tons of saleable steel.

Gas Pipe-line in Gujarat

121. Shri P. C. Borooah: Will the Minister of Mines and Fuel be pleased to state:

(a) whether a decision has been taken on the scheme of the Oil and Natural Gas Commission for supplying gas through a net work of pipe-line in Gujarat;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) what is its cost?

The Minister of Mines and Fuel (Shri K. D. Malaviya): (a) No, Sir.

(a) whether it is a fact that a Chinese resident of the Capital was arrested on the 10th April, 1962 by the Delhi Police;

(c) how many Chinese residents of the Capital have been arrested so far?
