सूचना और प्रसारण मन्त्रालय में उप-मन्त्री (श्री राम नाथ) : (क) ५३ टेक्नीविजन सेट दिल्ली में उन स्थानों पर लगाये गए हैं जहाँ सामुदायिक कार्यक्रमों के लिये टेक्नीकल से संघटित की गई हैं और २०१ सेट हायर मेकअपरी क्लर्कों के लिये लगाये गए हैं।

(ख) जी, हाँ।

(ग) मिनट २१ में ही जो आकाशवाणी में भारतीय निवृत्तों के बताने में एक ऐसी कर्म में खरोबि थे जो उनकी १९५५ की औद्योगिक प्रदर्शनी में दिल्ली के लिए लाए थे, वही यहाँ सेट बिना मूल्य मिले हैं। २७ सेट यू.ए.की निकाले गये हैं, प्रायः ४२० सेट कांटे फायरडेमा के अमराताय में।

### Riots in East Pakistan

Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state whether India has received reply to the protest note sent to Pakistan in connection with recent riots in East Pakistan?

**The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru):** No, Sir. Pakistan Government has not replied to us.

### Assistance from East German Firm

2160. **Shri Raghunath Singh:** Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state whether it is a fact that an East German firm of Cable Works in East Berlin has offered technical assistance to a private sector firm of Calcutta?

**The Minister of Industry in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Shri Kanungo):** Yes, Sir. Messrs. Aluminium Cables and Conductors (U.P.) Private Ltd., Calcutta, have entered into a collaboration agreement with Messrs. VEB Kablewerk Oberspree of Berlin and Messrs. A. G. Limex of the German Democratic Republic for the manufacture of paper insulated power cables.

### Trade with Kenya

2161. **Shri P. C. Borooah:** Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Kenya Minister of Economic Planning has urged India in particular to buy more from Kenya to balance the payments position between the two countries; and

(b) if so, Government's response to this demand?

**The Minister of International Trade in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah):** (a) and (b). Government have no information beyond a report to that effect which appeared in the local press. Enquiries are, however, being made.

### Spinning Mills in Gujarat

2162. **Shri Man Singh Patel:** Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

(a) how many spindles for spinning mills were allotted to Gujarat State in the first year of the Third Five Year Plan;

(b) whether licences for these spindles have been issued;

(c) if so, who have been given these licences and at what places;

(d) the criteria to grant such licences; and

(e) whether any effort was made to organise a cooperative society and offer licence to it?

**The Minister of International Trade in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah):** (a) 75,000 spindles.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) to (e). A statement is laid on the Table [See Appendix III, annexure No. 47].

**Retrenchment in the Former Ministry of Rehabilitation**

**2163. Shri P. R. Chakraverti:** Will the Minister of Works, Housing and Supply be pleased to state:

(a) the number of persons retrenched in the former Ministry of Rehabilitation till the end of March, 1962;

(b) the number of the retrenched employees who have secured re-employment through the Employment Exchange and the cell that has been set up in the Ministry of Labour and Employment; and

(c) whether any interim allowance has been paid to them for the period when they were out of employment?

**The Minister of Works, Housing and Supply (Shri Mehr Chand Khanna):** (a) 5,422 persons were retrenched transferred from 1957 till the end of March, 1962.

(b) Between 1st January, 1960 and end of March, 1962, 2,510 retrenched employees were re-employed through the Employment Exchanges, the Special Cell in the Directorate General of Employment and Training and the Special Selection Board. In addition, 433 officials were absorbed by

transfer to other offices. Many more must have also secured employment through their own efforts and prior to 1st January, 1960, for which figures are not available.

(c) No. Efforts are made to provide alternative jobs to the retrenched employees either during the period of notice or terminal leave when they get their pay.
