## Uranium in M. P.

## 2126. { Shri Subodh Hansda: Shri S. C. Samanta:

Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the survey to ascertain the potentiality of uranium deposits in Drug District in Madhya Pradesh has been completed; and

(b) if so, the result thereof?

The Prime Minister, and Minister of External Affairs and Ministry of Atomic Energy (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): (a) and (b). Exploratory surface surveys started by the Atomic Minerals Division of the Department of Atomic Energy in 1960 near Baghnadi village in the Drug District of Madhya Pradesh for uranium deposits are still continuing. No. fresh occurrences have so far come to light.

Sub-surface investigations by drilling were undertaken in the area in which the surface surveys carried out in 1960-61 brought to light the occurrence of uranium deposits. These investigations, however, had to be temporarily suspended as the drills had to be diverted to meet the urgent needs of more important prospects in Bihar, Rajasthan and Andhra Pradesh. Work will be resumed as soon as the drills are released from those areas.
