(b) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Defence (Shri Y. B. Chavan): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. Training in Mountain Warfare already formed part of normal training imparted to certain formations. However, in keeping with our new operational requirements this aspect of training is being given special emphasis and will include advanced and specialised training in fighting in high altitudes. It will, however, not be in public interest to disclose the details.

Training of Pilots For M.I.Gs.

879. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) whether some Indian Air Force Pilots have sent to Russia for having training in the Soviet Union to Fly MIG 21 Jets due to be supplied to India;

(b) if so their number and duration of training and whether these pilots will fly the MIGs to India;

(c) whether any phased programme of production of MIGs in India and the training of pilots for the same have been chalked out; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Defence (Shri Y. B. Chavan): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) It is not in the public interest to give their number and duration of training; nor information about the mode of transport of the aircraft to India.

(c) and (d): A phased programme of production of MIGs in India is being worked out. The training of pilots will be related to this programme.

Demand For Newsprint

880. Shri Koya: Will the Minister of Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state what arrangements are being made to meet the increased demand of newsprints due to increased

circulation of newspapers during the Emergency?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (Shri Sham Nath): In view of the difficult foreign exchange position, it is not possible at present to arrange for additional newsprint to meet the requirements of growing circulation during emergency. Newspapers have been advised to adjust their pages in order to meet the increase in circulation.

Haj Pilgrims

881. Shri Koya: Will the Prime Minister be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 2521 on the 7th September, 1962 and state whether the investigations about Paramount Travel Agency for cheating Haj Pilgrims have been completed and if so, what action has been taken?

The Prime Minister and Minister of External Affairs and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shri Jawaharlal Nehru): Yes. Shri Saeeduddin Ahmad, Manager of the Paramount Travel Agency was arrested and a case has been registered under Section 420/379/406 I.P.C.
