Import of Steel from U.S.S.R.

1985. { **Shri Yallamanda Reddy:**
Shri Elayaperumal:

Will the Minister of **Mines and Fuel** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are importing steel from the Soviet Union for the expansion of the thermal power station at Neyveli in Madras State;

(b) if so, the quantity being imported;

(c) the rate at which it is being imported; and

(d) other terms of the agreement?

The Minister of Mines and Fuel (Shri K. D. Malaviya): (a) and (b). The Neyveli Lignite Corporation are importing from the Soviet Union 1174 metric tonnes of steel for the 50 MW unit (sixth unit) of the Neyveli thermal expansion scheme.

(c) 115.20 Roubles or roughly Rs. 609.20 per tonne, c.i.f. Madras Port.

(d) The steel is being supplied under the 337.5 million rouble Soviet credit of September, 1959 and will be delivered within the 1st half of 1963. Supply of steel for the 100 MW unit (seventh unit) would be on terms to be mutually agreed upon between the Corporation and the Soviet organisation after the project report for the expansion scheme is received and accepted.

Training for Underground Water Prospecting

1987. Shri Tan Singh: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the number of trainees from India who received training for underground water prospecting in arid zones, organised at Lahore from 26th March to 20th April, 1962;

(b) the extent of expenditure borne partly by the Government of India and UNESCO;

(c) whether the services of these trained persons are utilized by Government; and

(d) if so, at what places and in what capacity?

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): (a) Six.

(b) No expenditure was incurred by Government as Unesco meets travel and maintenance costs of participants in regional training courses.

(c) & (d). The trainees were lecturers in the Departments of geology or geophysics in the Universities of Andhra, Baroda and Nagpur and in the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur.

It is expected that their experience in the training course will have been found useful to them in their work.

Women's Hostel, Utkal University

(a) whether any Central grants were given to the Utkal University (Orissa) for setting up Women's Hostel and for organising Cultural Festivals since 1959 to date; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

of Rs. 1723.00 was sanctioned for the Inter-Collegiate Youth Festival held during 1961-62.

The proposal of the University to construct a Hostel for Women students is under the consideration of the University Grants Commission.
