

(b) No Sir; only those students who register themselves with the University of Ranchi and pass the prescribed University examinations in conformity with the rules of the University, are awarded following degrees by the University;

- (1) B.Sc. (with Hons.) in Mining Engineering after 4 years of study;
- (2) B.Sc. (Hons.) in Petroleum Technology after 4 years of study;
- (3) B.Sc. (Hons) in Applied Geology after three years of study;
- (4) M.Sc. in Applied Geology after one year of study at post-B.Sc. (Hons) level in Applied Geology;
- (5) B.Sc. (Hons) in Applied Geophysics after 3 years of study;
- (6) M.Sc. in Applied Geophysics after one year of study at post-B.Sc. (Hons) level in Geophysics.

(c) The question of anomaly does not arise.

(d) Yes Sir, A proposal is under consideration of Government to register the School under the Societies Registration Act of 1860 and to empower it to grant academic awards by virtue of powers derived under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.
