(c) Apart from their normal activities to rehabilitate the denuded and degraded Forests the State Governments have made a provision of Rs. 12.16 crores for raising Forest Plantations over an area of 7,01,000 acres during the Third Five Year Plan period.

With a view to giving a further fillip to this activity and also to meeting the growing demand of wood based industries the Government of India has sponsored a scheme to bring about 1,37,500 acres under quick growing species with plan outlay of Rs. 2.75 crores to be entirely borne by the Central Government as a Centrally sponsored scheme. Under this scheme it is estimated that an area of about 60,000 acres will have been covered by the end of 1963-64.

It is proposed to continue these schemes on an expanded scale in subsequent plans also with an emphasis on extending areas under forests.

#### Loss of Money from Alipore Post Office

The Deputy Minister in the Department of Posts and Telegraphs (Shri Bhagavati): (a) Yes, Sir. The amount was found missing on the 16th November, 1963 from the bag placed in an iron chest embedded in Alipore Civil Treasury. (b) Police and departmental enquiries are in progress.

(c) Four postal officials arrested in the first instance, have been released on bail. A sum of Rs. 49,337 was recovered by the police during the course of enquiries. Some police officials have been arrested. Investigation is in progress.
