Supply of Surgarcane to Mills

Shri Rameshwar Tantia: 817. — Bishanchander Seth: Shri Vishwa Nath Pandey:

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that on account of fall in sugarcane production some of the sugar mills in Bihar and Eastern U.P. could not work fully; and

(b) the steps taken to increase the crop of sugarcane in the area?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. M. Thomas): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) A scheme has been sanctioned in these areas for intensive development of sugarcane cultivation in factory areas from this year.

Ticketless Traveiling

818. Shri Vishwa Nath Pandey: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that special campaign against ticketless travelling was launched by the Northern Railway from 8th February to 12th February 1964; and

Railway Wagons sent to Pakistan

820. Shri Surendranath Dwivedy: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Railway Wagons sent to Pakistan carrying cement during the years 1961 to 1963;

(b) how many of these have been returned to our country and how many are still lying there; and

(c) the total amount of cement supplied by these wagons during the above period?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Railways (Shri S. V. Ramaswamy): (a) 2884 wagons. Of these 268 wagons booked in 1961 for stations on the Pakistan Railways were meant for Afghanistan.

(b) The procedure for interchange of wagons between Indian and Pakistan Railways is the same as that obtaining between the Indian Zonal Railways, i.e. interchangeable alı wagons can be loaded from one country to the other irrespective of ownership of such wagons; ownership has significance only for charging of hire and execution of periodical overhaul. During the years 1961 to 1963 a total of 2,62,865 wagons (both loaded and empty) were sent from the Pakistan Railways to the Indian Railways and 2,63,185 wagons were sent from Indian Railways to Pakistan Railways. The location of one country's wagons in the other is verified once in alternate by the process of a wagon years census. In add tion, records are maintained, inter alia, to indicate the number of wagons of each country available on the other's system, as on the last day of each month.

Caravelle Services

(a) whether it is a fact that the Caravelle services are not running to scheduled time; and

(b) if so, the reasons therefor?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Transport (Shri Ahmed Mohiuddin): (a) and (b). The Caravelle services were introduced with effect from 1st February, 1964. There have been delays in the operation of these services due to traffic, catering, operations and engineering, but these should be regarded a_s the normal teething troubles incidental to the introduction of a new type of aircraft.

Sugarcane

(a) the number of sugar factories in the country that have represented to Government for shortage of sugarcane; and
