क्या गृह-कार्य मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या यह सच है कि ग्राम जलकोट, तहसील महेश्वर, जिला खरगोन, मध्य प्रदेश, में होली के अवसर पर किसी ने बम गाड़ दिया था;

(ख) क्या उस बम के फटने से होली की पूजा करने वालों में से ५ व्यक्तियों की मृत्यु हो गई, ६ घायल हुए और सारा ग्राम जल कर राख हो गया;

(ग) क्या यह सच है कि उक्त बम सेना के कर्मचारियों ने एक मुसलमान को २०० रुपये में बेचा था और इस प्रकार के कई बम कुछ और व्यक्तियों को बेचे गये हैं; और

(घ) क्या महू छावनी के डिफेंस स्टोर से चांदमारी के समय जो बम गायब हुए थे उनके बारे में कोई जांच की गई है और यदि हां, तो कुल कितने बम गायब थे ?

गृह-कार्य मंत्रालय में उपमंत्री (श्री स० ना० मिश्र) : (क) जी हां ।

(ख) दो व्यक्ति उसी स्थान पर गए, दो अन्य व्यक्ति बाद में हजरत लगे

मरे, तथा पांच व्यक्तियों को गहरी चोटें लगीं । यह बात सत्य नहीं है कि सारा गांव जल कर राख हो गया । आग से केवल पशुओं के एक शैड को क्षति पहुंची ।

(ग) जी नहीं ।

(घ) सैनिक अधिकारियों से यह मालूम हुआ है, कि चांदमारी के पश्चात् चार ब्लाइंड (अर्थात् बे बम्ब जो नुक्स आदि होने के कारण फटे नहीं थे) नष्ट करने के हेतु नहीं मिल सके तथा २६-१०-१९६२ को इस मामले की रिपोर्ट मंडलेश्वर के सर्कल इन्स्पेक्टर आक पुलिस को की गई ।

Abolition of Illiteracy

Shri Vishwa Nath Pandey:

Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Indian National Commission for Co-operation with the UNESCO has urged that UNESCO should take up urgently a project for the abolition of illiteracy in the areas of overwhelming illiteracy in the world; and

(b) if so, the reaction of the UNESCO thereto?

The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla): (a) and (b). The Indian National Commission for Co-operation with Unesco at its Sixth Conference held in New Delhi on March 21-22, 1964 adopted a resolution recommending that Unesco should take up the abolition of illiteracy in the areas of overwhelming illiteracy in the world as a Major Project of an urgent nature and strive to arouse the conscience of the world and mobilise world resources so that world illiteracy is reduced to minor proportions in a comparatively short period of time.

This recommendation will be sent to Unesco for consideration at its next

General Conference to be held in October-November 1964. The Conference will adopt the programme and budget of the Organization for 1965-66 which will reflect the reaction of UNESCO to this recommendation.

Awards for Scientific Research

2193. Shri Ram Harkh Yadav: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have approved the awards for outstanding works in scientific subjects for the years 1960 to 1962; and

(b) if so, the number of the recipients of the awards with reference to their subjects?

The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla): (a) Yes, Sir, except for two for the year 1962.

(b) 2 for Physical Sciences; 3 for Chemical Sciences; 2 for Biological Sciences; 2 for Engineering; and 1 for medical Sciences.

Youth Hostels in Orissa

Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the amount actually allotted to Orissa State for the construction of youth hostels in the State during 1963-64;

(b) the places where such hostels have been constructed during the same period; and

(c) the amount proposed to be given to the State for the purpose during 1964-65?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Education (Shri Bhakt Darshan): (a) Rs. 20,000 was released as the second and final instalment for the Youth Hostel at Gopalpur.

(b) Grants have been sanctioned by the Central Government for the construction of Youth Hostels in

Orissa at 2 places—Bhubaneswar and Gopalpur. The first instalments were released in 1960-61 and 1961-62 respectively.

(c) Rs. 20,000 will be released as the final instalment of grant for the Youth Hostel at Bhubaneswar on receipt of the prescribed utility certificate in respect of the first instalment.

Sangeet Natak Akademi Aid to Orissa

Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether Sangeet Natak Akademi gave any financial assistance to Orissa for promotion of Oriya dramas in the State during 1963-64; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. The Sangeet Natak Akademi gave a grant of Rs. 6,500 to the Utkal Natya Sangh, Cuttack, for research on 'Jatra' in rural areas in Orissa.

Civil Defence Organisation

2196. Shri Rishang Keishing: Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the total expenditure incurred by the Central Government in 1963-64 for Civil Defence Organisation; and

(b) the extent of assistance and co-operation received from the State Governments?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri L. N. Mishra): (a) The information is being collected from the various Ministries and will be placed on the Table of the House.

(b) The State Governments are taking action to implement Civil Defence measures in accordance with the policy laid down by the Centre.
