The Lok Sabha met at Eleven of the Clock

(MR. SPEAKER in the Chair)

SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA HALDER (Durgapur): Sir, the security arrangements that are being made.....(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: It is under the control of the House.

श्री मनीराम बागड़ी (हिसार): इतना कौन सा खतरा है? इसकी कोई जरूरत नहीं है। सदन को सदन रहने दो। कौन सा डर आ गया है?

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY (Calcutta South): What is this security arrangement? Are we having security problems? Why this security arrangement. ...(Interruptions)

श्री राम विलास पासवान (हाजीपुर): हमको गेट पर रोका गया है। आपको मेम्बर्स आफ पालियामेंट को साथ लेकर चलना पड़ेगा...

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY: This is the first time in the history of the House this extreme arrangement is being made. Are we having any security problems? (*Interruptions*) It is between you and us. You don't trust us?

(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: I was asked in this House last session about the security arrangements. As I explained to you that very day, since you have entrusted that work to me as Speaker, it was my duty to ensure the dignity, integrity and safety of this House. So, in consultation with the leaders of various groups and parties in this House, we have installed this. It is up to this House....

PROF. MADHU DANDAVATE (Rajapur): Not for the members.

श्री मनोराम बागड़ो : हम इसे नहीं चाहते हैं।

MR. SPEAKER: This is what is decided by the members. There is no problem. Whatever was decided by the leaders of parties is being done. If you don't want it, I have no objection.

श्री मनीराम बागड़ी: मैं नहीं चाहता हूं... (व्यवधान)...

MR. SPEAKER: Look here, this is a democratic set up and if you felt....

(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: The only thing is, this is something which I was entrusted with by the leaders of the parties in the House. If they decide not to have it, then I am not going to have it. If they say we want to have it, I shall welcome it. I am only concerned with that.

श्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी (नई दिल्ली):
अध्यक्ष जी, जो चर्चा हुई थी उसको ठीक तरह से
पेश नहीं किया जा रहा है, माफ़ की जिए। आपने
एक फैसला ले लिया था। वह फैसला अमल में
आने लगा था। जब विरोधी दलों के नेताओं के

सामने आया तो हमने कहा — आप जिस व्यवस्था को लागू कर रहे हैं उससे देश में यह भावना पैदा होगी कि देश में असुरक्षा है…

MR. SPEAKER: There is no question about it.

श्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेंगी: आपने कहा था कि हमने तय कर लिया है। तब हमने कम्प्रोमाइज के रूप में यह माना था कि मेम्बर्स को इसमें से निकाल दीजिए। अब आप अपने भाषण से ऐसी भावना पैदा न होने दें कि इस व्यवस्था में हमारा पूरा सहयोग है।

अध्यक्ष महोदय: मैंने कहा था — जितनी आपको चाहिये उतनी व्यवस्था करेंगे। अगर आप आज फैसला करेंगे कि नहीं चाहिए तो मैं हटवा देता हूं।

Again the leaders can meet. There is no problem in that. I cannot go anyway I like. I have been entrusted with this by the leaders. I have to do whatever the members say.

श्री मनोराम बागड़ो ः हाउस कह रहा है कि नहीं च।हिए।

MR. SPEAKER: Please sit down.

SHRI RATANSINH RAJDA (Bombay South): Mr. Speaker, Sir, this is highly objectionable.

SHRI SAMAR MUKHERJEE (Howrah): Before introducing these measures we were not consulted. That should be on record.

MR. SPEAKER: Look here, Mr. Mukheee, I was asked on the floor of the House.

I am on record here—I gave an understanding that I would take whatever steps are necessary. And whatever steps I took I put before them. I did it on the instructions of this House and I am still open to it.

(Interruptions)

श्री मनोराम बागड़ो: हम यह नहीं मानेंगे, चाहे मेम्बरी चली जाए।

श्री रशीद मसूद (सहारतपुर): जब आपने यह डिसाइड किया, उसके पहले अपोजीशन के लीडर्स से कह देते।

SHRI RATANSINH RAJDA: Mr.

Speaker, Sir, I object to the way in which this is worded in the Bulletin Part II. It is stated here: "Pursuant to an incident in the House during the last Budget Session..." It is casting a slur on an hon. Member of the House. That is wrong—the way in which this is worded. This is from Part II of the bulletin.

MR. SPEAKER: There is nothing derogatory about the Members.

SHRI RATANSINH RAJDA: By referring to an incident during the last Budget Session you are casting a slur on somebody. I object to it vehemently. Now, whose security is in danger? I would like to ask.

(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: I know it, Mr. Halder. You will be held responsible.

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRA-BORTY: What exactly is in your mind?

अध्यक्ष महोदय : मुझसे पृछा गया था।

Mr. Chakraborty, see the proceedings.

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY: You are the Speaker, Sir.

(Interruptions).

MR. SPEAKER: See the proceedings of the House.

(Interruptions).

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY: How can the Members be brought in his?

(Interruptions).

श्री राम विलास पासवान : अध्यक्ष जी, मेम्बर को यहां आने से कैसे रोकेंगे।

अध्यक्ष महोदय: मेम्बर को कोई नहीं रोकेगा।

श्री राम विलास पासवान: आप मेरी बात सुनिये।

अध्यक्ष महोदय: मेम्बर को कोई नहीं रोक रहा है।

श्री राम विलास पासवान : मैं एक व्यवस्था की बात करता हूं । मैं यह कहना चाहता हूं कि जब आप गेट पर आदमी रखते हैं तो पालियामेंट के स्टाफ का कोई आदमी वहां पर क्यों नहीं रखते हैं। आप दिल्ली पुलिस के कांस्टेबिल को वहां लगा देते हैं।

श्री राम विलास पासवान: अब मेम्बर क्या कार्ड लिए चला करेंगे।

MR. SPEAKER: Why shouldn't we?

श्री राम विलास पासवान : पालियामेंट हाउस के मेम्बर यहां आने के लिए कार्ड लेकर चला करेंगे।

अध्यक्ष महोदय : कार्ड रखने में हर्ज क्या है। आप इसको बन्द करवा दें।

श्री राम विलास पासवान : हम गले में कार्ड लटका कर चलेंगे।

अध्यक्ष महोदय: अब यह तो जो आप डिसा-इड करेंगे, वही होगा। जो आप सब कहेंगे, वही कर देंगे। हम और कुछ नहीं करेंगे। हम इस बारे में फिर बैठ सकते हैं और दोबारा फैसला कर सकते हैं।

अध्यक्ष महोदय : ऐसा करने से क्या होता है। अब दुबारा मीटिंग कर लेंगे 1

SHR! RATANSINH RAJDA: The security of the Members in this House is not in danger.

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY: We are part of democracy, but we not find that in the House. (Interruptions).

MR. SPEAKER: This is what you are asking me to do.

(Interruptions).

SHRI SATYASADHAN CHAKRABOR-TY: (*Interruptions*) We do not find it in the House. What is this democracy? (*Interruptions*).

MR. SPEAKER: What is this?

(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: No, no. There is no question of that. Do not misquote, do not mis-represent.

(Interruptions)

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, SPORTS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BUTA SINGH): As you have rightly pointed out and you are very kind to observe what has been done inside the Parliament House is strictly in pursuance of the assurance given by you on the floor of this House. Government received the directives in writing. This arrangement had to be done; these arrangements were organised. You were kind enough to call a meeting of the leaders of the opposition. In that meeting these arrangements were placed before them. They discussed it. They modified them to a great extent and accordingly these arrangements were modified.

Whatever assurance is given by the hon. Speaker becomes a directive to us. We have to implement it. Not only the life of the hon. Members present here, the life of every one entering this august House has to be secure and has to be made safe. (*Interruptions*).

It is easy for the opposition to frame any charge on the Government or the ruling party. But does this House not know that it is only the hon. Member Opposite who was instrumental in carrying a live pistol in this House? How can we deny the fact?

PROF. MADHU DANDAVATE: Not 'live',

SHRI BUTA SINGH: This is not only that...(Interruptions). I am yet to complete. (Interruptions).

It is too much to say that we are trying to create this atmosphere inside the House. We are not going to point a finger to anybody present in this House as to who is responsible, but the fact remains the hon. Members of this House....(Interruptions)

SHRI RATANSINH RAJDA: There was no live pistol at all.

SHRI BUTA SINGH: Hon. Members bring people without any valid pass or any document.

It is an established practice in all Houses. Even the Members of the United Nations have to carry their identity cards. The Members of the Security Council have to carry the identity cards. The purpose of having identity card precisely is that you can be identified. In this House the Members are identified by Watch and Ward Staff. (Interruptions). It is to protect the life of the Members of Parliament. It is for the safety of the Members of Parliament that this arrangement had to be made.

अध्यक्ष महोदय : आनरेबल मेम्बर, जरा आप • बैठ जाइये और मेरी बात सुनिए। देखिए • •

Every Member is a Member first and anything afterwards. There is no question of differentiation for me. I cannot differentiate between a Member and a Member. Every hon. Member of this august House, is honourable and equally respectable. He has the same right and he has to go through the same processes. So, there is no differentiation. But still I will go along with the consensus of this august House and for that I can always give that assurance.

(Interruptions)

JHU SPAN

MR. SPEAKER: Why do you interrupt me? You must have the courtesy of at least listening me.

SHRI HARIKESH BAHADUR (Gorakhpur): You call a meeting of the leaders. MR. SPEAKER: That is what I did. And I am again....

(Interruptions)

OBITUARY REFERENCE

MR. SPEAKER: Hon. Members, as we meet today after an interval of two and half months, it is my sad duty to inform the House of the passing away of a former Speaker of this House, Sardar Hukam Singh who passed away at New Delhi on 27 May, 1983 at the age of 88.

A noted Parliamentarian, Sardar Hukam Singh was a member of Constituent Assembly, Provisional Parliament and the first three Lok Sabhas during the years, 1948-67.

In March, 1956, Sardar Hukam Singh, at that time a member of Opposition and a member of the Panel of Chairmen, was elected to the Office of the Deputy Speaker. He was re-elected as Deputy Speaker of Second Lok Sabha.

He was unanimously elected to the high office of the Speaker, Third Lok Sabha in April, 1962 and continued in that Office till March, 1967.

Sardar Hukam Singh had an amiable personality. He was deeply devoted to Parliamentary institutions and made a very distinguished contribution as a Presiding Officer in the form of decisions and rulings from the Chair.

As a Deputy Speaker in the Second-Lok Sabha, he was the Chairman of the Committee of Privileges, the Committee on Private Members' Bills and Resolutions and the Committee on Subordinate Legislation.

In his capacity as the Speaker of Lok Sabha, he was elected as the first President of the Institute of Constitutional and Parliamentary Studies.

During his tenure as Speaker, he led Indian Parliamentary Delegations to USSR and Mangolian Peoples Republic, United States of America, West Germany, United Kingdom and Philippines. He also led Indian Delegations to Commonwealth Parliamentary Conference held at Lagos in Nigeria and Kuala Lumpur in Malaysia. He served as a member of the General Council of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Conference for two years.

Sardar Hukam Singh was appointed as Governor of Rajasthan in April, 1967 and served there till 1972.

A deeply religious man, Sardar Hukam Singh was an intellectual, social reformer and an able administrator. He won widespread respect for his qualities of head and heart, unfailing sense of courtesy and dignified behaviour.

In his passing away, the country has lost a dedicated son who devoted himself to the service of people and the democratic institutions.

We deeply mourn the loss of this friend and I am sure the House will join me in conveying our condolences to the bereaved family.

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): Sir, I rise to express our sorrow at Sardar Hukam Singh's death. He presided over the proceedings of this august House with dignity and impartiality and earnestness and earned the respect of all sections of the House.

Sardar Hukam Singh came to this high office after many decades of public service in Punjab. Later, he rendered further distinguished service as Governor of Rajasthan.

Please extend our deep sympathy to the family and friends.

SHRI SAMAR MUKHERJEE (Howrah): I fully associate with the sentiments expressed here by you and by the Prime Minister. Though I am not personally acquainted with Sardar Hukam Singh and his works, his name was long before known to me as one of the outstanding parliamentarians and one of the notable Speakers. His contributions have already been mentioned. A loss of this type of outstanding parliamentarian is really a loss to our parliamentary democracy and the people.

So I request you to convey our condolences to the bereaved family.

PROF. MADHU DANDAVATE (Rajapur): Mr. Speaker, Sir, we are offering our tribute today to one of the most towering personalities of the country who occupied the high office of Speaker with great distinction, dignity and impartiality. Sardar Hukam Singh occupied the Chair which you are occupying today, he neither looked to the left nor looked to the right but looked straight to the portrait, which is hung there, of Shri Vithalbhai Patel who remained a challenge to the establishment, who maintained the dignity of this House, who established the supremacy of the Legislature over the Executive. He also contributed through his rulings to a free and fair debate and discussion on various matters, including the privileges and the rights of this House. I was going through the various rulings given by Sardar Hukam Singh as Speaker and I found that on a number of occasions he did something that needs to be emulated. The best tribute to Sardar Hukam Singh will come not only from the Members of this House but from you, Sir, because there is something to be emulated. For instance, on 2nd August, 1966, when some procedural matters regarding the Minister's attitude to the PAC Reports were raised through a privilege motion, he did not take it as a technical issue and did not say 'Not admitted; not admitted'; he said that the procedural matter needed to be discussed in the House and he allowed the matter to be raised by Shri Madhu Limaye. The matter was discussed. The Finance Minister said that it was really a healthy and democratic debate on both sides. For half an hour the admissibility was discussed and though ultimately it was rejected, the whole House was able to hear a lot. Such was the great work that he did in this House, he protected the rights and privileges of every Member, and that is really the legacy of this great man who has passed away. With his religious background he had imbibed deep religious values into the institution for which he worked, he brought the democratic spirit to this institution, he brought fearlessness to this institution, he brought impartiality to this institution. To preserve these values and to inculcate them in the life of this Lok Sabha is a real tribute to Sardar Hukam Singh.

श्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी (नई दिल्ली): अध्यक्ष महायद, सरदार हुकम सिंह के निधन से एक व्यक्तित्व हमारे बीच से उठ गया है और सार्वजनिक जीवन में एक महत्वपूर्ण स्थान रिक्त हो गया है। अनेक पदों को गरिमा के साथ अलंकृत करने के बाद जब सरदार हुकम सिंह जी ने राज्य-पाल के पद से अवकाश ग्रहण किया तो उन्होंने बड़ी शांति और धैर्य से जीवन की संध्या में प्रवेश किया। उस समय मैंने एक निस्पृहता, एक निरा-सक्ति उनके निकट अनुभव की। मेरी आखिरी मुलाकात उनसे उस समारोह में हुई थी जो डा॰ श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी को श्रद्धांजलि अपित करने के लिए आयोजित हुई थी। सरदार हुकम सिंह जी डा० श्यामा प्रसाद मुखर्जी द्वारा गठित नेशनल डिमोकेटिक फंट के सदस्य थे, जो 1952 में लोक सभा में गठित हुई थी। सरदार साहब पहले अकाली दल से सम्बद्ध थे लेकिन उपाध्यक्ष और अध्यक्ष के पद पर बैठने के बाद उन्होंने अपने को सिक्रय राजनीति से अलग किया और निष्पक्षता के साथ कर्तव्य पालन का प्रयत्न किया। वे दृढ़ भी थे, उदार भी थे, नियमों के प्रति जागरुक भी थे और व्यावहारिक भी थे। वे जानते थे संसद भारतीय गणराज्य के हृदय की धड़कन का प्रतिनिधित्व क्रती है। यह धड़कन अगर सुनी नहीं गई, इस धड़कन को अवरुद्ध करने का प्रयत्न हुआ तो लोक-तन्त्र सफल नहीं होगा, सार्थक नहीं होगा।

अध्यक्ष के नाते एक प्रश्न जो लगातार उनके मन को मथता था वह यह था कि अध्यक्ष को अपने चुनाव के लिए बहुमत पार्टी पर निर्भर रहना पड़ता है लेकिन उसे अपने कर्तव्य का निष्पक्षता के साथ पालन भी करना पड़ता है। मैं उनके भाषणों का संग्रह देख रहा था, आप क्षमा करें, मैं उसमें से एक अंश उद्धृत करना चाहता हूं:

"There is another thing worth consideration. The Speaker has to seek election every five years. To get himself elected he must have the support of his Party. It is in the interests of the majority party that the Speaker commands the confidence and respect of the minority. But this is seldom realised and the ruling party on certain

occasions expects some favours. If the Speaker agrees, then he must be charged with partiality. If he refuses, then next time there will be pressure in his party that he must be replaced."

अध्यक्ष महोदय, उनके निधन से मुझे ऐसा लगता है मेरी व्यक्तिगत क्षति हुई है। मुझे उनके निकट काम करने का मौका मिला था। उनके निधन से आज हम सभी दुःखी हैं, आप हमारी संवेदनाएं उनके परिवार तक पहुंचा दें।

SHRI C.T. DHANDAPANI (Pollachi): Glowing tributes have been paid to the past Speaker of this House. He was one of the noted parliamentarians of our time. He took social service as his political career as soon as he came out of the College. Despite the fact that he was a social reformer, he was an intellectual, administrator and a parliamentarian.

As the previous speakers have stated, he set a precedent how the office of Speaker should function and he was also a Deputy-Speaker elected from the Opposition.

He remained as a Member of the Opposition and had completed his term as Deputy-Speaker. He was a great personality of our time. Of course, it is a great loss to our country.

I request you to convey the condolences of our Party to the bereaved family.

MR. SPEAKER: Shri Indrajit Gupta. Not here. Shri Ramavatar Shastri.

It necessary for me to add anything further to the tributes which have been paid by various sections of this House and leaders of parties and groups to different aspects of his contributions to our parliamentary life and to the strengthening of democratic traditions in the country. I once again join my voice with the sentiments that have been expressed here and we wish that you may convey these sentiments to the bereaved family.

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काम होते थे उनमें उन्होंने अपना योगदान दिया और सामाजिक और धार्मिक कामों के लिए जबिक आज देश में ऐसे लोगों की आवश्यकता है जोकि समाज को एक नई दिशा दे सकें अपने योगदान के जरिये, ऐसे वक्त में उनका हमारे बीच से उठना लोगों को महसूस होगा। मैं उनके प्रति और उनके तमाम प्रशंसनीय कार्यों के प्रति अपनी श्रद्धांजिल अर्पित करता हूं।

भी जगजीवन राम (सासाराम): अध्यक्ष जी, सरदार हुकुम सिंह जिस पीढ़ी के प्रतीक थे उसके लोग एक के बाद एक उठते चले जा रहे हैं। उनकी प्रतिभा बहुमुखी थी और उनका कार्य-क्षेत्र बहुत विस्तृत था और किस पहलू पर कहा जाए और किस पर न कहा जाए, मैं असमंजस में पड़ जाता ह्रं ।

जब वे इस पद पर आए थे तो सारा जीवन न्याय दिलाने की अनुभूति को साथ ले कर आए थे । इसलिए यहां भी बैठ करके उन्होंने न्याय दिलाने का प्रयत्न किया और उन्होंने जो कुछ भी रूलिंग्स दी हैं, उनको आज भी देखा जाए, तो मालम होगा कि सदन के भिन्त-भिन्त हिस्सों को न्याय दिलाने में वे हिचकते नहीं थे। यह एक बड़ी चीज थी। मैंने जैसाकि पहले कहा है कि उनका कार्य-क्षेत्र बहुत विस्तृत था। सदन के भीतर और सदन के बाहर चाहे जिस पद पर भी वे रहे हों! इन्सानियत को कभी भी उन्होंने नहीं खोया और यही कारण या कि उनके साथ जिनकी सहमति नहीं होती थी, वे लोग भी उनकी ओर आकृष्ट होते थे और उनकी प्रशंसा करते थे।

सरदार हुकुम सिंह अकाली दल के थे लेकिन मैं कहुंगा कि वे अच्छे और सच्चे सिख थे। वे एक बहुत बड़े भारतीय थे, प्रजातन्त्र के बहुत बड़े पोषक थे और यह मानते थे कि प्रजातन्त्र को हम जितना सशक्त करेंगे उतना ही देश को शक्तिशाली बनाया जा सकेगा, देश को एकत्रित रखा जा सकेगा।

मैं अधिक समय न लेकर, उनके सम्बन्ध में पूर्वं वक्ताओं ने जो कुछ कहा है, उससे अपने आपको जोड़ता हूं और उनके प्रति अपनी विनम्न श्रद्धांजलि व्यक्त करता हूं।
