

(b) The note of the Government of India dated 28th July, which has been released to the press, related primarily to an instance of seven armed Chinese military personnel intruding into an area near Fukche in Ladakh. This area falls in the 20 k.m. demilitarized zone specified under the Colombo Proposals. Similar military activities, where small Chinese patrol parties intruded into Indian territory, were observed near Kongka La, Jara La, and Chang La areas in Ladakh.

(c) The Chinese Government have replied to this note on September 1 denying that they had carried out military activities in the demilitarized area.

Pak. Nationals in Garden Reach Workshop, Calcutta

(c) During January to June, 1964, 35 Pakistani nationals had submitted their resignations.

(d) While all were accepted initially, one clerk was permitted to withdraw his resignation as he owed a lot of money to the Credit society, with a view to safeguard the interest of several Indian nationals who had stood surety for him.

Shift System in Ordnance Factories

(b) whether any one of them had been working to the fullest capacity?

The Minister of Defence Production in the Ministry of Defence (Shri A. M. Thomas): (a) The Chemicals and Explosives Factories, having processes of a continuous nature, are working on three shifts. All the other Ordnance and Clothing Factories are working on two shifts.

(b) All the factories had been working to the fullest capacity.

Retirement of J.C.Os.

1332. **Shri R. G. Dubey:** Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the J.C.Os. in the ASC(SD), cadre of the Indian Army are made to retire from service even before completing 55 years of service; and

(b) if so, the reasons for this disparity?

The Minister of Defence (Shri Y. B. Chavan): (a) and (b). The terms regarding retirement from service of J.C.Os. are similar in all arms of the Service and are not linked with age limits. Subedar and Jemadar Head Clerks ASC(SD) retire after completion of 28 years pensionable service whereas Subedar Majors [Clerks ASC(SD)] retire after completion of 5 years tenure as Subedar Major or 32 years of service whichever is earlier.

J.C.Os. ASC(SD) who originally belonged to IACC, on combatation in 1942, were, however, given an option to continue in service upto 55 years of age or 30 years of service whichever was earlier. Those who accepted this option have alone been allowed to continue in service likewise irrespective of the service limits.
