Atomic Research

The Prime Minister and Minister of Atomic Energy (Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri): The Department of Atomic Energy publishes every year annual report on its activities as weil as a monthly journal titled Nuclear India. The Department's activities are also depicted in exhibitions, in which it participates both in India and abroad. Publicity is furthermore given in newspapers, over the radio. etc., whenever an important event with which the Department is concerned occurs. Distinguished foreign visitors, who have occasion to come to Bombay, are usually shown round the Atomic Energy Establishment Trombay, so that they can obtain for themselves an idea of India's progress in the atomic energy field.
