(b) if so, the Soviet Government's reaction thereto?

The Minister of Finance (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): (a) and (b). There have been general discussions with the Soviet authorities for assistance for the Fourth Five Year Plan and this matter is still in a preliminary stage.

(a) whether there has been any noticeable improvement in the profits of the public sector companies during 1963-64; and

(b) the extent to which these compare with the average profitability of private sector companies? The Minister of Finance (Shri T. T. Krishnamachari): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The comparison of the nature suggested is not feasible.

(a) whether the Committee set up by Government to study the problems of small towns in the hilly and border areas has since completed its report; and

The Minister of Health (Dr. Sushila Nayar): (a) Yes. Copies of the Report are being placed in Parliament Library.

The report has been forwarded to all the State Governments/Union Territories and the concerned Ministries of the Central Government for taking action on the recommendations with which they are concerned.
