The Minister of Industrial Development and Company Affairs (Shri F. A. Ahmed): (a) There is only one unit in the public sector which has been licensed to manufacture Upthalmic Class.

(b) The licensed capacity is 300 tonnes per annum. The unit is yet to go into production.

(c) There is no indigenous production of this item at present and the entire requirements are being imported.

(d) The unit is likely to go into trial production in October, 1967 and is expected to take care of the entire demand of the country when in full p oduction.
