Manufacture of Diesel Locomotives

2302. Shri Narendra Singh Mahida: Shri N. K. Sanghi: Shri Ramachandra Ulaka: Shri Shankarrao Mano:

Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Diesel Locomotive Works, Varanasi propose to manufacture 40 diesel locomotives for metre gauge by the end of 1989;
- (b) if so, the cost of diesel locomotive;
- (c) whether the designing for these lecomotives to be manufactured for the first time by this workshop will be done by a foreign firm;
- (d) if so, the name and other details of the firm;
- (e) whether Canada has sanctioned two million dollars for this purpose;

- (f) if so, the details of the amount

The Minister of Rallways (Shri C. M. Poenscha): (a) Yes.

- (b) The U.S.A. ex-factory cost is \$168,000 per locomotive (excluding escalation charges). The estimated cost of manufacture at the Diesel Lecomotive Works is about Rs. 14 lakks per locomotive.
- (e) and (d). The mere gauge diesel seemotives are to be manufactured to see (Ai) LSD-4.

the design of the American Collaborators of the Diesel Locomotive Works, Messrs. ALLO products Inc., who are already supplying the design of the broad gauge diesel locomotives being built at present at the Diesel Locomotive Works.

(e) and (f). Candian \$2.2 million equivalent to Rs. 1.52 crores has been allocated from the non-project loan of C. \$11.85 million granted by the Government of Canada, for the purpose of purchasing imported components for the 40 metre gauge locomotives.

Kota-Chitorgarh Railway Line
