EXPORT OF SYNTHETIC DRUGS AND SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS

3406. SHRI S. C. BESRA: SHRI MARANDI:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government had sponsored four members' delegation for West Asia to prospect the market for synthetic drugs antibiotics and surgical instruments;
- (b) if so, the success achieved by the delegation; and
- (c) the number of countries visited by the delegation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND OF SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI RAGHURAMAIAH): (a) The Government had approved the pro-

posal of Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd. to send a three members Trade Delegation to Middle East, and East African countries to explore the possibilities of export of surgical instruments and other products of the Company to those countries.

Written Answers

(b) The delegation found that there was a good market for surgical instruments, having regard to the quality and prices of the products of Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd. compared to other competitors in the field. The delegation has quoted for three tenders and Indian Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd. have received the notice for three more tenders. They also obtained on the spot orders for small supplies.
