Note: Schemes covering an expenditure of more than 25% of a social nature such as sum clearance/housing for weaker sections are financed at a subsidised rate of interest of 6½% with ¼% rebate for prompt payments. All other schemes are financed at the normal rate of interest (presently being 8% less ½% rebate for prompt payments).
