licensed capacity in respect of 54 priority industries would be a help or expanding the base for export production. over, applications received from exportoriented units for capital goods licenses, industrial licenses and/or for foreign collaboration are being processed on a priority basis through the various licensing mechanisms. Improving efficiency of production, reduction of cost and adaptation of production to meet the requirements of foreign customers are adequately taken into account while processing the applications of export units for various types of oriented licences.

(b) & (c). The Fourth Plan target for annual growth of exports is 7 per cent. Although export performance may vary from year to year, Government are confident that the average annual rate of growth of exports during the Fourth Plan period will be close to the plan target. This will make an important contribution to the realization of the objective of self-sustained growth.

Closure of Staple Yarn Units in Ludhiana
