### Introduction of a Direct trian from Delhi to Kanyakumari

- 64. SHRI M. K. KRISHNAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government are examining the question of introducing a direct train from Delhi to Kanyakumari;
  - (b) when it is likely to start; and
- (c) the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA): (a) to (c). Conversion of the Ernakulam-Trivandrum M. G. section to B. G. (at a cost of Rs. 13.60 crores) has already been sanctioned and construction of the Trivandrum-Cape Comorm-Tirunelveli BG rail link (at a cost of Rs. 14.53 crores), is under active consideration. Introduction of a direct train from Delhi to Kanyakumari can be considered only after the construction of the Trivandium-Cape Comorin line which would take about 4 years after it is sanctioned.

### Double Railway line from Cochin to Shoranur (Southern Railway)

- 65. SHRI C. JANARDHANAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased of state:
- (a) whether the plan for doubling the Railway line between Cochin and Shoranur has been finalised;
- (b) if so, an outline and the estimated cost thereof, and
- (c) when the work is expected to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA):
(a) Yes.

- (b) Patch doubling of 18 km between (i) Mullurcarei-Wadakancheri and (ii) Pudukad-Irinjalakuda estimated to cost Re. 200 lakhs is under consideration.
- (c) It will take about three years to complete the work after the estimate for the work is sanctioned.

## Decline in Export of Pepper to Italy and Canada

- 66. SHRI C. JANARDHANAN: Will the Minister of FOREIGN TRADE be pleased to state:
- (c) whether export of pepper to Italy and Canada has registered a decline in the last three years;
  - (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken to arrest the decline?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FORIEGN TRADE (SHRI A. C. GEORGE): (a) Export of pepper to Italy has declined during the last three years. Export of pepper to Canada during 1970-71 was higher than that during 1968-69 but lower than that during 1969-70 in quantity but more in value realization. Statement of exports of Pepper to Italy & Canada for the years 1968-69, 1969-70 and 1970-71 is given in Statement.

- (b) Higher price of Indian Pepper than other Competing varieties.
- (c) No specific measures are envisaged in relation to Italy and Canada but efforts are being made to secure an overall increase in our exports of Pepper.
