been significantly liberalised to ensure a fuller utilisation of installed capacity in various industries:

- Industrial licensing procedures have been streamlined and the pace of licensing has been accelerated:
- The value of import licensing of Capital Goods has also been increased considerably; and
- -Licensing of import of steel has been stepped up. During 1971-72 import licensing of other critical raw materials has also been increased

Investigation of Faulty Telephone Connections

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI H. N. BAHUGUNA): It is presumed that the Hon'ble Members have sought information about faulty connections in the working of the crossbar exchanges, equipment for which has been imported from Belgium. If so, the reply is as follows:

- (a) No. Deficiencies in the crossbar exchanges were noticed during their installation and after their commissioning. These have been investigated and discussed in a series of meetings between the Indian Telecommunication Engineers and representatives of Belgiun Firm to find solutions to improve the working of these exchanges.
- (b) No. There are different versions of the Crossbar System of Telephone exchanges each having its own special features. The Pentaconta system of exchanges which was imported is one of them and is known as Crossbar System all over the world.
- (c) Does not arise in view of reply to (b) above.
