Requirement of Railway Wagons During Fifth Five Year Plan

(a) whether Government have made any assessment about the requirement of Railway Wagons during the Fifth Five Year Plan; and

(b) if so, the outcome thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MOHD. SHAFI QURESHI): (a) Yes.

(b) Two alternative exercises have been undertaken. The Railways assessment based on past trends is that the freight traffic by the end of the Fifth Plan may be around 280 million tonnes for which about 1.09 lakh wagons will be required. However, the projection given by other sectors total upto about 335 million tonnes for which about 2.04 lakh wagons will be required. A final view on this will be taken after the freight traffic target is finalised by the Planning Commission.
