Construction of Houses for Harijans and Sweepers in Municipal Towns

9695. SHRI B. K. DASCHOWDHURY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have any scheme for construction of houses for Harijans and Sweepers working in Municipal towns; and
- (b) if, so, what are those schemes and hether such schemes—can be taken up whether such schemes directly by the Central Government or the Harijans and Sweepers themselves can directly approach the Central Government for giving them such financial help?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F. H. MOHSIN): (a) and (b). Funds are being provided for the acquisition of land for house-sites. The scheme of subsidy for sweepers, housing and provision of housesites for Scheduled Castes engaged in unclean occupations are included in the Central Sector. For other categories of Scheduled Castes, provision is made in the State Sector. The cost of housing under the Backward Classes Sector is generally reckoned as Rs. 1,200 per house; it is reckoned as Rs. 1,600 in black soil areas, hilly regions and remote places; in areas bordering the Himalayas and subject to heavy snowfall, it is reckoned at Rs. 2,000. Seventy five % of the cost of construction of a house is given as subsidy and the balance can be contributed by the beneficiary in the form of cash, labour, building material etc.

Grants-in-aid for the housing schemes are given by the Centre to the State Governments/U.T. Admns. No direct grant is given by the Centre to individuals.

Criterion for Scheduling of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes

9697. SHRI KARTIK ORAON: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state whether the tribe or caste by birth is the criterion for the scheduling of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI F. H. MOHSIN): The Schreduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes are specified in the Presidential Orders issued in pursuance of articles 341 and 342 of the Constitution. Whether a particular person belongs to a particular Scheduled Caste or Tribe is a question of fact, and each case has to be determined on its own merits.

Assistance for providing infra-Financial structural facilities in Jodhpur Division

9698. SHRIMATI KRISHNA KUMARI: Will the Minister of INDUSTRIAL DEVE-LOPMENT AND SCIENCE AND TECH-NOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Jodhpur Division of Rajas-than possesses sufficient industrial potential and whether Government propose to give necessary financial assistance to the State Government for providing suitable infrastructural facilities there, and

(b) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOP-MENT (SHRI ZIAUR RAHMAN ANSA-RI): (a) and (b). The Small Scale Industries Development Organisation has conducted surveys of the districts of Nagaur, Barmer and Sirohi in the Jodhpur Division and have suggested that there is scope for the setting up of industries for the manufacture of shoes, washing soap, processed foods, straw board and units for tanning and bone crushing.

The six districts of Jodhpur Division, Barmer, Jaisalmer Jalore, Jodhpur, Nag-aur and Sirohi are eligible for concessional finance from the financial institutions for the setting up of new industrial units. In addition new industries in the districts of
