3161. श्री फूलचन्द वर्मा : क्या पूर्ति और पुनर्वास मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या मध्य प्रदेश के माना शरणाधीनों के रूप में रहने वाले 100 शरणाधीन परिवारों के लगभग 500 सदस्यों को इंदौर में बसाने के लिए भेजा गया है ?

(ख) यदि हां, तो उन्हें वहाँ पर क्या-क्या सुविधायें प्रदान की गई हैं ?

(ग) क्या इंदौर में भेजे गये शरणाधीन परिवारों को भुखमरी और बेरोजगारी का सामना करना पड़ रहा है और वे वहाँ पर इधर-उधर मारे-मारे फिर रहे हैं ? और

(घ) इन शरणाधीन परिवारों की शोध राहत प्रदान करने हेतु सरकार ने कौन-कौन से ठोस कदम उठाये हैं और उसका न्यौरा क्या है ?

Moratorium of Strikes

3162. SHRI RAMAVATAR SHASTRI: Will the Minister of LABOUR be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have a proposal under consideration to declare moratorium on strikes in the public sector for a period of three years; and

(b) if so, the main features and objectives thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI BALGOVIND VERMA): (a) There is no such proposal at present.

(b) Does not arise.

Accidents in Mines

3163. DR. RANEN SEN: Will the Minister of LABOUR be pleased to state:

(a) whether the accidents in the mines have increased recently; and

(b) if so, the reasons thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI BALGOVIND VERMA): (a) and (b). According to the provisional available information, there were 267 fatal accidents and 2,669 serious accidents during 1974 as compared to 251 fatal accidents and 2,593 serious accidents during 1973. The Government is concerned about this matter.

Policy of Commonwealth on South Rhodesia

3164. SHRI PRIYA RANJAN DAS MUNSI: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any efforts have been made by Government to persuade the Commonwealth for a policy on South Rhodesia against Colonial White oppression; and

(b) if so, the result thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI BIPINPAL DAS): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir. This issue has been discussed at various Commonwealth Heads of Government Conferences. We have fully supported the cause of the African people against colonial white oppression and for majority rule in Southern Rhodesia. At the last Conference in 1973 in Ottawa, Heads of Government expressed their intense concern for the situation in Southern Rhodesia. They noted that the responsibility for a settlement lay with the British Government and were united in their willingness to contribute towards a solution. All
