- (b) These matters are constantly under review of the Government and the L.I.C. The L.I.C. has taken, inter-alia, the followng steps:
  - (i) As part of expenditure control the cadre strongth of the administrative staff has been frozen at the level obtaining on 1-4-1974.
  - (ii) A detailed exercise has been made to simplify the procedures, so that the offices can cope with increased value of work without increase in staff strength.
- (iii) Interest earnings are maximised by careful selection of investments and planning of the cash flow.

## Reservation of Posts for S. C. and S.T. in Branches of Allahabad Bank, Calcutta

6718. SHRT P. M. SAYEED : Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of posts of typists, clerks and cashiers filled in various branches in Calcutta of the Allahabad Bank, during \$975 \$974 and first two months of 1975;
- (b) the number of posts reserved in each category during this period, for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;
- (c) whether all the reserved posts were filled; and
- (d) if not; the reasons for reserved posts remaining vacant when a larger number of reserved category candidates had actually passed in the written test?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRIMATI SUSHILA ROHATGI): (a) The recruitment of Clerks, Typists and Cashiers made by Calcutta branches of Allahabad Bank during 1973, 1974 and first two months of 1975 is given in the table below :

- (b) During this period, 78 and 14 posts were reserved for Scheduled Clastes Tribes in the categories of Clerks and Typists respectively.
- (c) and (d) According to the bank, all the reserved posts could not be filled because of lack of suitable candidates. The unfilled vacancies have been carried over to be filled in future recruitments.

However, the possibility of augmenting trade between the two countries has been discussed by both sides from time to time and is kept under review.
