

(c) According to the latest procedure followed, the foreign companies are not given fresh formulation capacities without its linkage with bulk drug production. In so far as Indian sector is concerned, a liberal policy is being followed and in case their ratio of production between bulk drug and formulation is 1:10 they are given approvals for production of formulations without their linkage to the bulk drug production.
