Instructions have been issued on 28th March 1977 that family planning should be purely on a voluntary basis and that there is no place for compulsion or coercion.

Reduction in Aid to Bangladesh

3493. SHRI R. V. SWAMINATHAN: SHRI NIHAR LASKAR:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether India has reduced aid to Bangladesh this year;

(b) if so, the amount of aid given to Bangladesh uptil now;

(c) the reasons for the reduction in aid; and

(d) whether the reduction in aid will harm the relation between the two countries?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI MORARJI DESAI); (a) to (c). Since the emergence of Bangladesh as an December, independent country in 1971, India has given government-togovernment assistance in the shape of grants and credits totalling Rs. 233.02 crores upto 31st March 1976. Thereafter no fresh government assistance has been committed to Bangladesh; therefore there is no question of reduction in our aid to that country during this year. However, goods are continuing to be supplied to Bangladesh against grants/credits committed earlier.
