Help to sick Jute and textile mills by IDBI

3737. SHRI SAUGATA ROY: Will the Minister of FINANCE AND RE-

VENUE AND BANKING be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Industrial Development Bank of India opened a 'soft loan window' to help sick jute and textile mills last year; and

(b) if so, what has been the success of the scheme in rehabilitating sick units in the jute and textile industries?

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE AND REVENUE AND BANKING (SHRI H. M. PATEL) : (a) and (b). At the instance of the Government of India, the Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI) introduced in November, 1976 a "Soft Loan Scheme" to provide assistance on concessional terms to five selected industries viz. sugar, cement, cotton, textiles, jute and certain engineering industries to enable them overcome problems relating to obsolescence, replacement and renovation of plant and equipment. The main criteria for extending assistance is promise of early viability of an undertaking based on the implementation of the modernisation scheme. The scheme is operated by the IDBI, the Industrial Finance Corporation of India (IFCI) and the Industrial Credit and Investment Corporation of India Limited (ICICI).

The details of applications received, rejected, sanctioned disbursed and pending as on 30-6-1977, under the scheme in respect of cotton textiles and jute are as under:—
