(a) Admission is mi de entirely on the basis of merit in the entrance examination which is conducted on All-India basis;
(b) \& (c). Out of 65 seats for MBBS 15 seats are reserved for State candidates as under:
Pondicherry öpen Genl. II
Podnd cherry open S.C.
Pond cherry open S.T
(d) The Institute has no part in oaper setting, valuation and assessment.
(e) The marks obtained by the candidates are not published but a list of selected candidates is displayed on the notice board and the selected candidates are informed immediate!y.
(a) Admission is mede on the basis of merit by holding competitive entrance examinat:on;
(b) No seats are reserved for any State or Union Territory including Delhi in which the AIIMS is located;
(c) For admission to MBBS Course $20 \%$ of the total seats are reserved for SC/ ST candidates.

For 2 dmission to Post-graduate courses, $25 \%$ of the total seats are re'ierved for those who have served in the rural areas for more than 2 years; medical graduates from backward areas, SC/ST candidates and those who are working under Family Welfare programme;
(d) For admission to MBBS courses, the paper setting and valuations is done by teachers from other Universities in India.

As regards admission to Postgraduate courses, paper setting, valuation and clinical assessment is done by faculty Members of the respective Departments. After the assessment by the faculty, the cand dates are finally interviewed by the Selection Committee consisting. of Director, Dean, a representative from the Dte. G.H.S., Head of the respective Department and one senior faculty member from the allied specialities.
(e) The Institute does not publish or notify either to the successful Cand:dates of others, the mumber of marks obtained by them in written viva-voce test.
(a) All the Selections to Post-graduate courses are made on merit on All-India basis. (There is no MBBS course in PGI).
(b) There is no reservation of seats for candidates hailing from the States in which the Institute is located;
(c) No seats are reserved for studeits from backward classes. Reservation is, however, made for candidates belonging to SC/ST.
(d) The staff is involved in the conduct of examination and assessment of the candidates.
(e) The marks obtained by all candidates, who are successful or otherwise in the written and practical/ clinical examinaticns are displayed on the Notice Board.
