THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIM.M. JACOB): (a) Such instances have come to notice.

(b) Mainly, the districts affected are Bombay, Nasik, Dhule, Nagpur and Wardha.

(c) Law and order is a State subject. However, the available intelligence inputs have been provided to the State Government from the Centre from time to time. Whatever assistance is possible will also be provided to the State.

New Petrol/Diesel Bunks on National Highways

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) Separate Volume-Distance norms for combined MS/HSD and Lone HSD retail outlets are laid down for opening such outlets on national highways.

(b) to (d). Representations are received from time to time for opening of retail outlets at different locations in the country including those in Andhra Pradesh. The oil companies on the basis of the market survey, economic viability and product availability, include such places in their Marketing Plan.
