merly Modern Bakeries (India) Limited produces bread at its 13 units located at Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Bombay, Calcutta, Chandigarh, Cochin, Delhi, Hyderabad, Indore, Jaipur, Kanpur, Madras and Ranchi. The bread produced at these units is sold in the local markets where the units are located and also in the neighbouring areas.

(b) to (e). As at present, the Company has no proposal to increase the production capacity of its existing units or to set up a new unit in Kerala.

OB Van for Tamil Nadu

3885. SHRI R. ANNANAMBI: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

the reasons for ignoring the Tamil Nadu State's request for an OB Van to telecast colour programmes?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V.N. GADGIL): The four colour OB Vans, procured after the Government's decision to introduce colour TV in the country in a phased manner, were deployed at Doordarshan Kendras in accordance with the scheme approved. equipment for limited production of fieldbased programmes in colour have already been provided to Doordarshan Kendra, Madras. Equipping one of the studios at this Kendra for operation in colour is also an approved scheme which is expected to be implemented by 1986-87. Provision of more colour OB Vans at various Doordarshan Kendras, including Doordarshan Kendra. Madras, will depend on the availability of resources for this purpose during future Plan period.

Government Offices in Private Buildings

3886. PROF. CHANDRA BHANU DEVI: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:

(a) whether many Central Offices in various parts of the country are housed in private buildings;

- (b) if so, the steps being taken by Government to shift these offices in Government buildings; and
- (c) whether Government are taking any concrete steps to provide more housing facilities, particularly in metropolitan cities, for Central Government employees?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI ABDUL GHAFOOR):
(a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The Ministry of Works and Housing is taking steps to construct office accommodation in various cities where Central Government Offices are located within the funds made available for the purpose.
- (c) Government propose to undertake substantial programme of construction and augmentation of residential accommodation in the 7th Five Year Plan. Details have, however, not yet been finalised.

Radio Stations in Rajasthan

3887. SHRI BANWARI LAL BAIRWA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Radio Stations working in Rajasthan;
- (b) whether Government propose to establish new Radio Stations in the State in the near future; and
 - (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GADGIL):
(a) Six.

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) The approved 6th Plan, contained a scheme for a new Radio Station with 1 kw mw transmitter at Kota. Construction of the building is in progress. The Station will be ready for commissioning by March, 1986.

Planning Commission has approved, in principle, the setting up of a Radio Station at Barmer with 20 kw mw transmitter, multipurpose studios, receiving facilities and staff
