- (c) the details of the scheme alongwith financial implication and out-turn thereof;
- (d) the targeted time for completion of the project and the benefit to be derived out of it; and
- (e) whether the scheme is being implemented near Kasafal north of Balasore district in Orissa; if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) and (b). No, Sir. However, a part of coastal belt of Orissa is included for development under the propsed Norwegian aided project on development of traditional fisheries in Balasore.

(c) to (e). The project site of the proposed project is at Kasafal in the Balasore district of Orissa. It is aimed at improving the living conditions of the weaker section of the population who are generally traditional fishermen. It involves construction of roads, ice plants, storages, and improvement of the marketing conditions. The project also envisages supply of drinking water, construction of fish curing yards, service station, work shop, jetty and provision of housing and medical facilities to the local fishermen populations. Recently, the Norwegian Agency for International Development (NORAD) has Norwegian Kroner 22.5 million for the implementation of the project. It is targetted to complete the project by 1987. The project is expected to improve the general standard of living of the population of the Kasafal area, specially of the poorest group and the fishermen families. It will be a pilot scheme for gaining experience for possible future development in other part of Balasore Coast line.

OB Van to Bangalore T.V. Center

3929. SHRI V. S. KRISHNA IYER: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) how many Outdoor Broadcasting (Television) Vans are there in the country;
- (b) whether Bangalore T. V. Centre has been provided with a OB Van; and

(c) if not, whether there is any proposal to provide one OB Van to Karnataka, particularly to Bangalore T. V. Center?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GADGIL): (a) Six.

(b) and (c). OB Vans are provided to Doordarshan Kendras in phases, subject to availability of resources. Provision of OB Van at Doordarshan Kendra, Bangalore would thus depend upon the availability of resources for this purpose during the future Plan period.

Amount Spent on Self-Employment Schmes in States

3930. PROF. P. J. KURIEN: Will the Minister of LABOUR be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount spent on Self-Employment programme in the county, State-wise;
 - (b) whether the target has heen achieved;
- (c) whether the target has not been achieved in Kerala due to non-co-operation of the banks and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) number of applications sanctioned and the number of applications pending in Kerala; and
- (e) action being taken to clear applications?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI T. ANJIAH): (a) The main Self-Employment Schemes under implementation in the country are Training of Rural Youth for Self-Employment (TRYSEM) and Scheme for providing Self-Employment to Educated Unemployed Youth. In addition, a scheme to Strengthen Employment Exchanges*/U.E.I. G. Bs for promotion of Self-Employment in 30 selected districts is also being operated. The amount spent on these schemes are contained in three Statements I, II and III respectively attached.

(b) Under the scheme to provide Self-Employment to Educated Unemployed Youth,
