Assistance by CLUSA and Canadian Cooperatives in oil seeds production

3989. SHRI M. RAGHUMA REDDY: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 1997 on 8 April, 1985 and state :

(a) details of assistance CLUSA and Canadian cooperatives, separately, have rendered for oilseeds production enhancement in India, rupee value of such assistance from each, year-wise, in Sixth Plan; its use, State-wise and year-wise and corresponding outcome to-date; (b) whether in Madhya Pradesh average Soyabean production per hectare declined after 1981-82 while area sown increased;

(c) if so, acreage and soyabean production, year-wise from 1982-83 to 1984-85, in Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh and all India percentage figures;

(d) whether in addition to assistance received in kind major part of edible, vegetable oil imported, year-wise, in Sixth Plan also was of soyabean; and

(e) if so, year-wise quantity of oil of each kind imported, price paid, country of origin and how distributed, State-wise ?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) The assistance obtained by National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) through the Cooperative League of U.S.A. (CLUSA) and Cooperative Union of Canada (CUC) in different years for oilseeds development is in the shape of gift refined soyabean oil and crude rapeseed oil. The details are as follows :-

(d) and (e) The assistance to National Dairy Development Board for the Project "Restructuring Edible Oilseeds Production and Marketing" from CLUSA and CUC has been in the nature of gift. The details of refined soyabean oil and crude rapeseed oil obtained year-wise have been given above in part (a) of the Question. No price is paid for the gifted soyabean and rapeseed oil. The CLUSA supplies the refined soyabean oil and CUC supplies the crude rapeseed oil. The gifted oil is distributed mainly to the State level Oilseed Growers Cooperative Federations.

(d) whether the district of Pali Marwar in Rajasthan will be surveyed for the above scheme for better utilisation of rainfall in the district ?

(b) to (d). The Government has accorded high priority to dryland development programmes which have been included as item No. 1 of the New 20-Point Programme. Broadly, these programmes aim at improving the productivity of land through appropriate land treatment measures coupled with suitable agronomical practics. The areas in which such developmental work is taken up are finanalised in consultation with the State Governments.
