## Completion of Idukki Hydro-Electric and Banasura Sagar Scheme

DR. K.G. ADIYODI: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

- work on Idukki (a) whether the Hydro-Electric and Banasura Sagar (Wynad Distt.) Scheme has since been completed:
  - (b) if so, when; and
  - (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARIF MOHAMMAD KHAN): (a) to (c) Stage I of Idukki Hydro Electric project is under operation since 1976. Unit-I under Stage II has already been commissioned and balance two units will be commissioned in Stage III of the project will be completed in 1987. The delay in completion of Stage III is mainly due to contractual Problems in execution of Erattayar dam.

Banasura Sagar dam is expected to be completed during 1989-90. The delay is mainly due to delay in acquisition of land and paucity of funds.

## Chlorine plants of Fertilizer Industries

- (a) whether it is a fact that the chlorine plants of fertilizer industry in the country are hazardous in populous areas and along busy arterial roads;
