

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH) : (a) to (d) Housing is State subject. Central financial assistance is given in the shape of block loans and block grants without being tied to any particular scheme or head of development. However, Housing and Urban Development Corporation (HUDCO), a Public Sector enterprise has sanctioned 63 schemes received from various housing agencies in Bihar involving a project cost of Rs. 68.75 crores with a loan commitment of Rs. 32.74 crores. This will enable the provision of 42,265 dwelling units, 42,700 basic sanitation units and development of 1073 plots.

**Allocation of Funds to States for
Implementation of IRDP**

(a) the Statewise amount allocated for the implementation of Integrated Kural Development Programme during the year 1984-85 and particularly to Orissa ;

(b) the amount spent by the Government of Orissa to implement the programme and the achievement made ;

(c) whether it is a fact that the funds allocated during 1985-86 to Orissa are not sufficient to meet the situation ;

(d) if so, whether Orissa State Government has approached the Centre to increase the fund ; and

(e) if so, the reaction of the Union Government thereon ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHANDULAL CHANDRAKAR) : (a) A statement is given below.

(b) During 1984-85 the Government of Orissa have incurred an expenditure of Rs. 2045.14 lakhs under I.R.D.P. and assisted 2,13,119 families.

(c) to (e) There is an allocation of Rs. 2496 lakhs to Orissa towards IRDP for 1985-86. The Government of Orissa have pointed out that this will not be sufficient to cover the target of Rs. 1,84,350 old beneficiaries fixed for supplementary assistance and 61,450 new beneficiaries with a minimum subsidy of Rs. 2000 per family. At the same time they have pointed out that only 59,660 old beneficiaries out of 2,38,776 assisted in the first two years will be eligible for further assistance, hence they have suggested that the target for old beneficiaries may be revised accordingly. The targets of old beneficiaries based on the house to house survey prescribed for this purpose is being reviewed and a discussion has been fixed for Orissa on 20.11.1985.
