Assistance to Farmers by N.C.D.C.

79. SHRI MANVENDRA SINGH : Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) The aid or benefit given to farmers by National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) ;

(b) The details of the assistance provided by NCDC to States during 1984-85, State-wise ; and

(c) The details of the programme which has been chalked out by NCDC for Seventh Five Year Plan ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA) : (a) The National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) is a promotional and developmental financing institution. It is responsible for

country-wide planning and promotion of programmes through cooperatives for storage, marketing and processing of agricultural produce, supply of agricultural inputs and for development of cooperatives for weaker sections like fishery, poultry, dairy, tribal cooperatives etc. NCDC has also been promoting and financing distribution of consumer articles in rural areas through cooperatives. Assistance from NCDC is provided to farmers cooperatives as part of the Central Sector Schemes of the Government and Corporation Sponsored Schemes through State Governments and State Cooperative Banks.

(b) During 1984-85, assistance provided by NCDC under Central Sector Schemes and Corporation Sponsored Schemes amounted to Rs. 124.706 crores. The State-wise details are given in the Statement below.
