Setting up of TV relay centre at Dhule

1002. SHRI MANIKRAO HODLYA GAVIT: Will the Minister of INFORMA-TION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether Dhule District of Maharashtra which is a thickly populated Adivasi belt has not been covered with the T. V. Relay Centres so far, and this area is quite ignorant of the world happening: and

(b) if so, whether Government propose to set-up relay Centres for this area and if not, the reasons thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GAD-GIL): (a) and (b). A part of Dhule District is covered by the low power (100 W) TV transmitter set up at Dhule in September, 1984. However, due to acute constraints of financial resources, it is not possible to further expand TV service in this district during the VII Plan period.

Drinking water supply programme in rural areas

1003. SHRI P.R. KUMARAMAN-GALAM : Will the Minister of AGRI-CULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government propose to integrate drinking water supply programme with health education under the Seventh Plan (Times of India dated 14.2.86), (b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether full training will be imparted on the dangers from drinking unprotected water and disease transmissions?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (S. BUTA SINGH) : (a) to (c) : The need for proper health education and promotion of health consciousness amongst the rural population in the context of the Drinking Water Supply programme has been given attention by the Government, A Working Group was also constituted on Health Education and community participation in water supply and sanitation. The Conference of State Ministers and officials in charge of rural water supply and sanitation which was held recently has emphasised the necessity for making health education relating to Rural Water Supply and Sanitation an integral part of the school education and non-formal education. Further details in this regard will be worked out for taking appropriate action.

Telecast of regional films on national network

(a) whether the rate payable to the regional films accepted for telecasting on the national net-work has been revised; and
