

(c) and (d). The Centre is expected to put out programmes catering for various sections of viewers in Gujarat for about 2.5-3 hours daily. The transmission will include developmental programmes contributed by the Space Applications Centre, Ahmedabad and will generally consist of items like news, current affairs, documentaries, TV features, music, dance, etc. The Centre will also relay the National Programme put out from Delhi.

**Improvement of cattle breeding

(a) whether Government are aware that the programme of improving milk yields of local cows through cross breeding with exotic bulls of Jersey, Holstein etc. has not made much impact in Assam; and

(b) if so, the steps proposed to be taken by Government to accelerate cattle development in Assam to improve their productivity ?
