

Savings Bank and Money Order Services at a single counter of the Post Office. There are three sub-offices in the Union Territory of Delhi having the facility of single window system. The system has been generally found satisfactory except for some operational difficulties for the staff.

(e) The system is already in existence in certain Post Offices in the cities outside Delhi. There is no proposal to introduce the system in the new sub-offices outside Delhi at present.

**Construction of departmental building
for Post Offices and Telephone
Exchanges**

1294. PROF. NARAIN CHAND PARASHAR : Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government have given any priority to the construction of departmental buildings for Head Post Offices/Sub Post Offices and Telephone Exchanges at (i) District Headquarters (ii) Sub-Divisional Headquarters and (iii) C.D. Block Headquarters;

(b) if so, the number of such Headquarters, State-wise in each category which have at least one departmental building in the Postal and Telecommunication wings at each one of these stations; and

(c) the likely date by which all such headquarters in each category would be provided departmental buildings for postal and telecommunication Departments and the funds provided for this purpose in Seventh Five Year Plan ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA) : (a) No, Sir. The construction of departmental buildings is taken up considering such factors as operational requirements, availability of land funds. As regards Telephone Exchanges, departmental buildings are only constructed for MAX-I exchanges.
